

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?














# **DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (WINDSOR-ESSEX)**

















# of Full-time vs Part-time Jobs







Job Postings by Years of Experience Required








#### **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
