








#### JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR WINDSOR-ESSEX

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?




#### NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

















# of Full-time vs Part-time Jobs




#### **JOB DURATION**

Permanency of jobs posted










## **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
