Shippers and Receivers ship, receive, and record the movement of parts, supplies, materials, equipment, and stock to and from an establishment.

Job Duties:

Shippers and Receivers determine method of shipment and arrange shipping; prepare bills of lading, customs forms, invoices, and other shipping documents manually or by computer. Shippers and Receivers assemble containers and crates, record contents manually or by computer, pack goods to be shipped, and affix identifying information and shipping instructions. They oversee loading and unloading of goods from trucks or other conveyances and inspect and verify incoming goods against invoices or other documents, record shortages, and reject damaged goods. Shippers and Receivers also unpack, code, and route goods to

appropriate storage areas and maintain internal, manual, or computerized record-keeping systems.

Working Conditions:

Work takes place in a conventional controlled environment such as an office, hospital or school.


Some work may be done in an outdoor work environment where the worker is exposed to variations in weather conditions and seasonal weather patterns.
