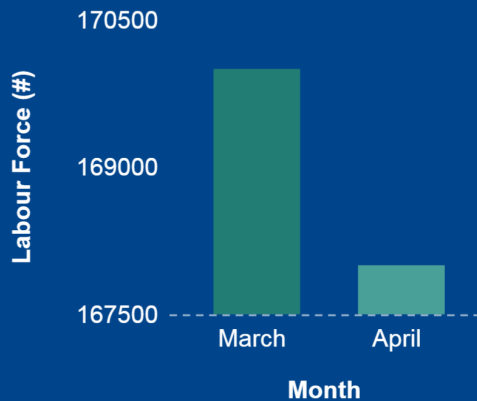

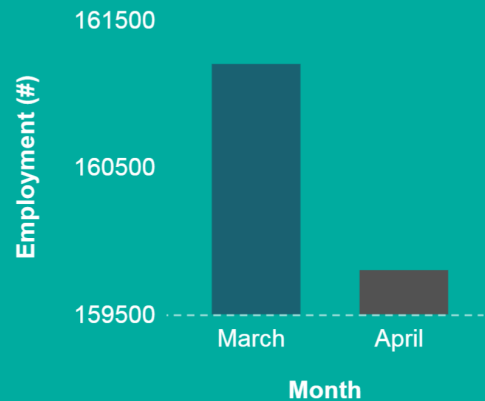

Labour Force



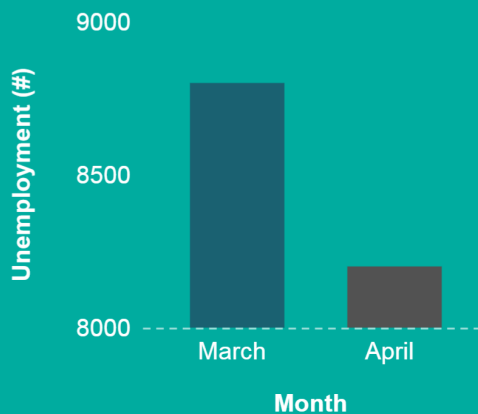
The labour force in Windsor CMA decreased 2000 from 170,000 in March to 168,000 in April.

Employment



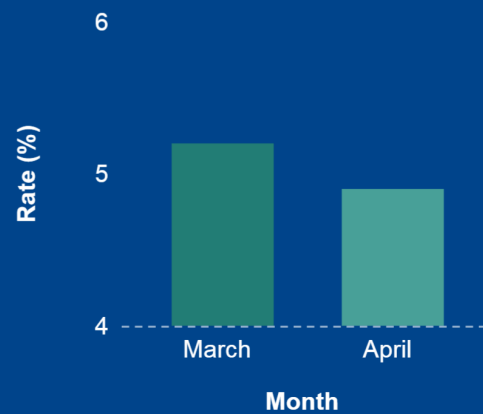
The level of employment in the Windsor CMA decreased 1,400 from 161,200 in March to 159,800 in April.

Unemployment



The number of unemployed individuals decreased 600 from 8,800 in March to 8,200 in April.

Unemployment Rate



The unemployment rate decreased from 5.2% in March to 4.9% in April.

Windsor CMA Participation Rate: 59.1%

Unemployment rate of Ontario: 5.8%

The unemployment rate of Windsor CMA is **1.2% less** than 12 months ago.

The labour force is seasonally adjusted, accounting and averaging for peaks in hiring around holidays, summer, etc.

The figures fall within the standard of error.
