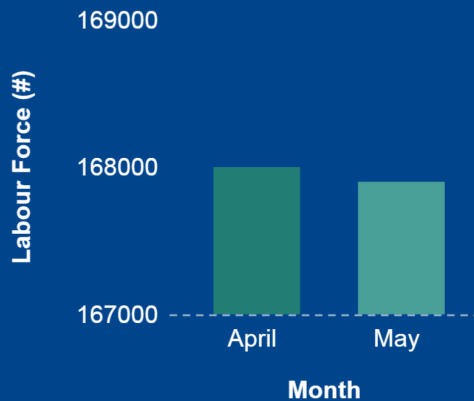

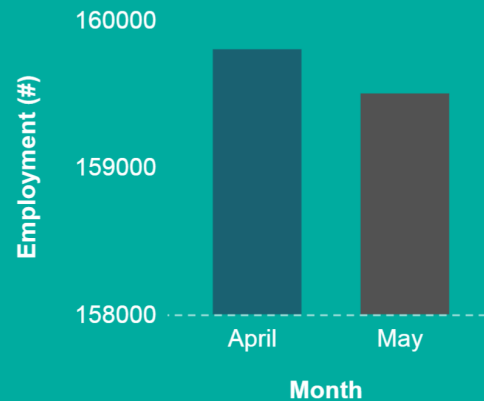

Labour Force



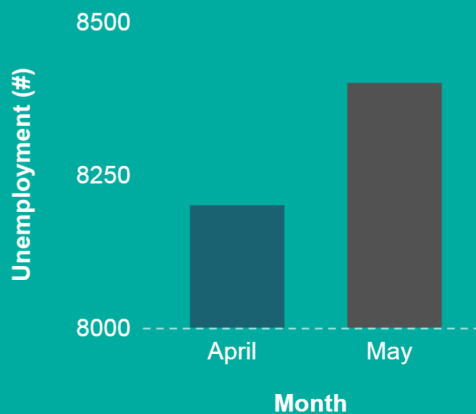
The labour force in Windsor CMA decreased 100 from 168,000 in April to 167,900 in May.

Employment



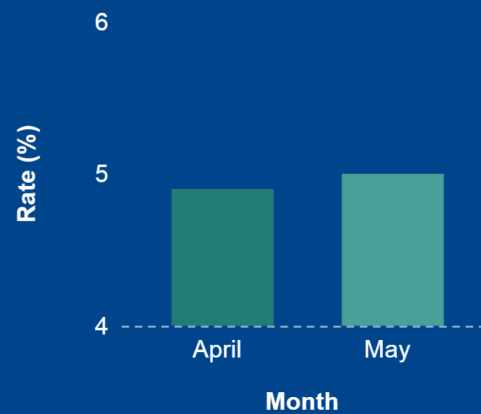
The level of employment in the Windsor CMA decreased 300 from 159,800 in April to 159,500 in May.

Unemployment



The number of unemployed individuals increased 200 from 8,200 in April to 8,400 in May.

Unemployment Rate



The unemployment rate increased from 4.9% in April to 5.0% in May.

Windsor CMA Participation Rate: 59.0%

Unemployment rate of Ontario: 6.5%

The unemployment rate of Windsor CMA is **1.2% less** than 12 months ago.

The labour force is seasonally adjusted, accounting and averaging for peaks in hiring around holidays, summer, etc.

The figures fall within the standard of error.
