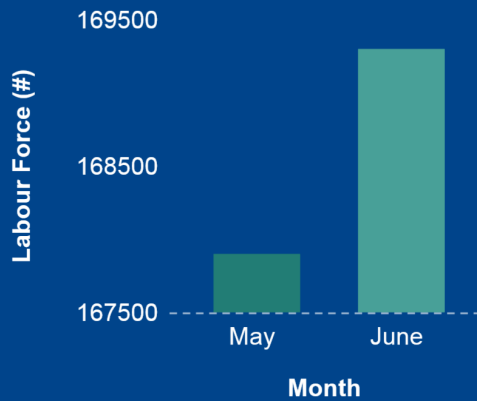

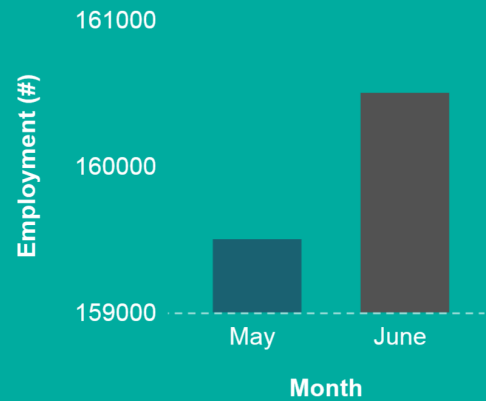

## Labour Force



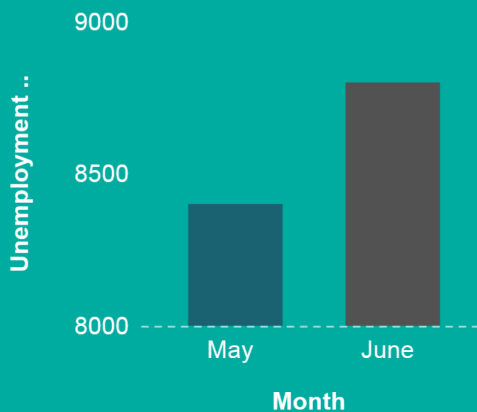
The labour force in Windsor CMA increased 1,400 from 167,900 in May to 169,300 in June.

## Employment



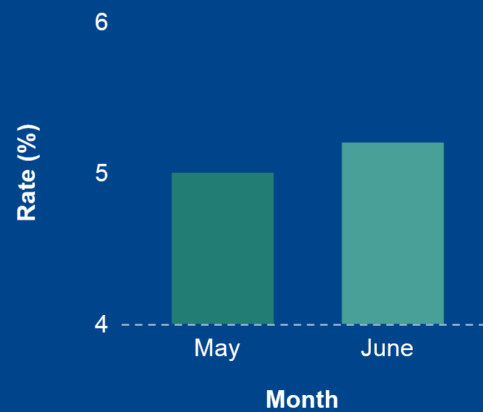
The level of employment in the Windsor CMA increased 1,000 from 159,500 in May to 160,500 in June.

## Unemployment



The number of unemployed individuals increased 400 from 8,400 in May to 8,800 in June.

## Unemployment Rate



The unemployment rate increased from 5.0% in May to 5.2% in June.

Windsor CMA Participation Rate: 59.5%

Unemployment rate of Ontario: 6.4%

The unemployment rate of Windsor CMA is **1.2% less** than 12 months ago.

The labour force is seasonally adjusted, accounting and averaging for peaks in hiring around holidays, summer, etc.

The figures fall within the standard of error.
