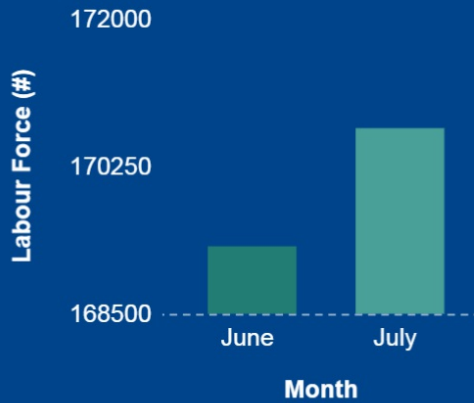

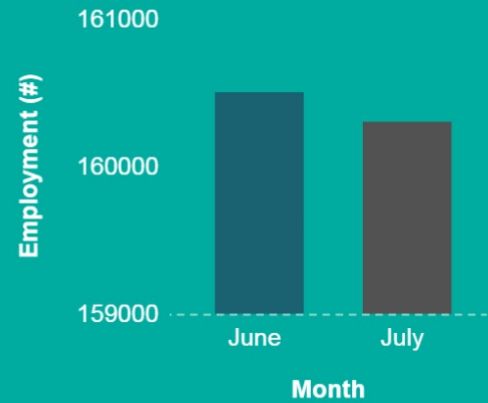

Labour Force



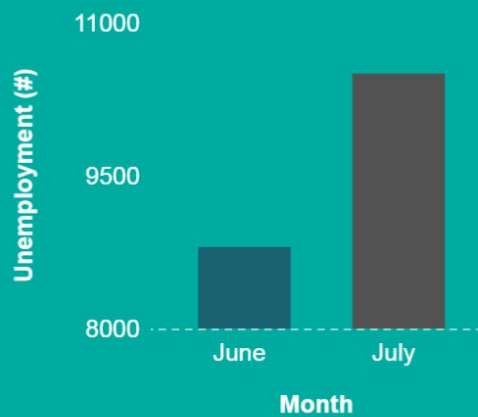
The labour force in Windsor CMA increased 1,400 from 169,300 in June to 170,700 in July.

Employment



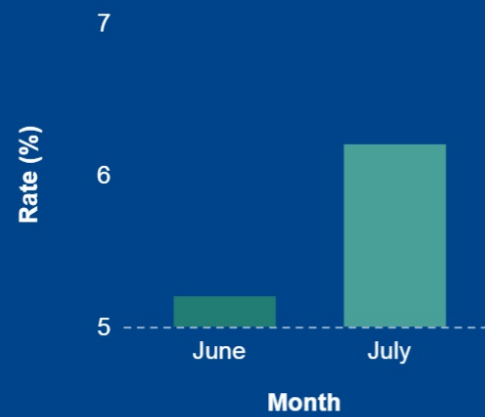
The level of employment in the Windsor CMA decreased 200 from 160,500 in June to 160,300 in July.

Unemployment



The number of unemployed individuals increased 1,700 from 8,800 in June to 10,500 in July.

Unemployment Rate



The unemployment rate increased from 5.2% in June to 6.2% in July.

Windsor CMA Participation Rate: 59.9%

Unemployment rate of Ontario: 6.1%

The unemployment rate of Windsor CMA is **0.2% less** than 12 months ago.

The labour force is seasonally adjusted, accounting and averaging for peaks in hiring around holidays, summer, etc.

The figures fall within the standard of error.
