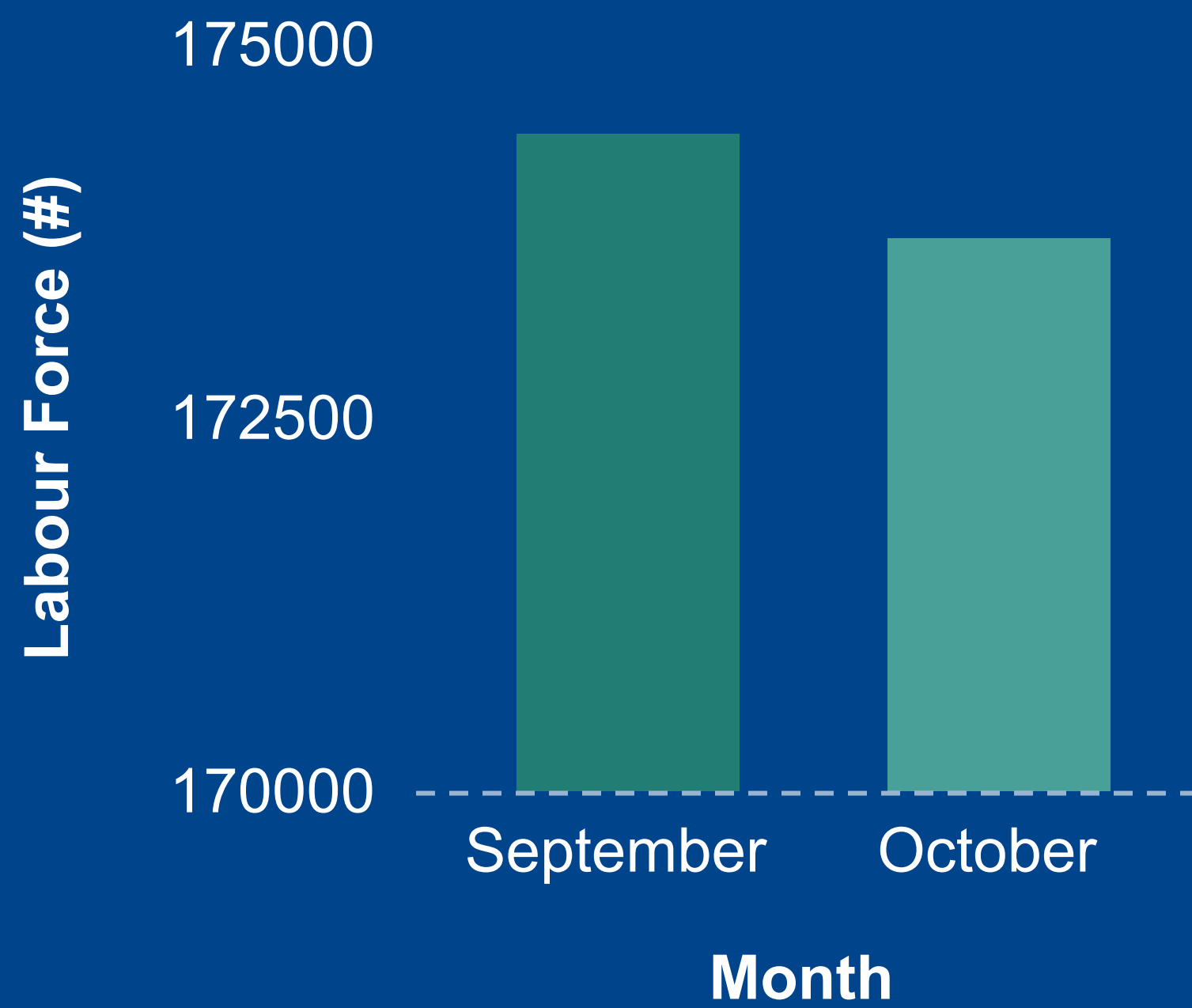

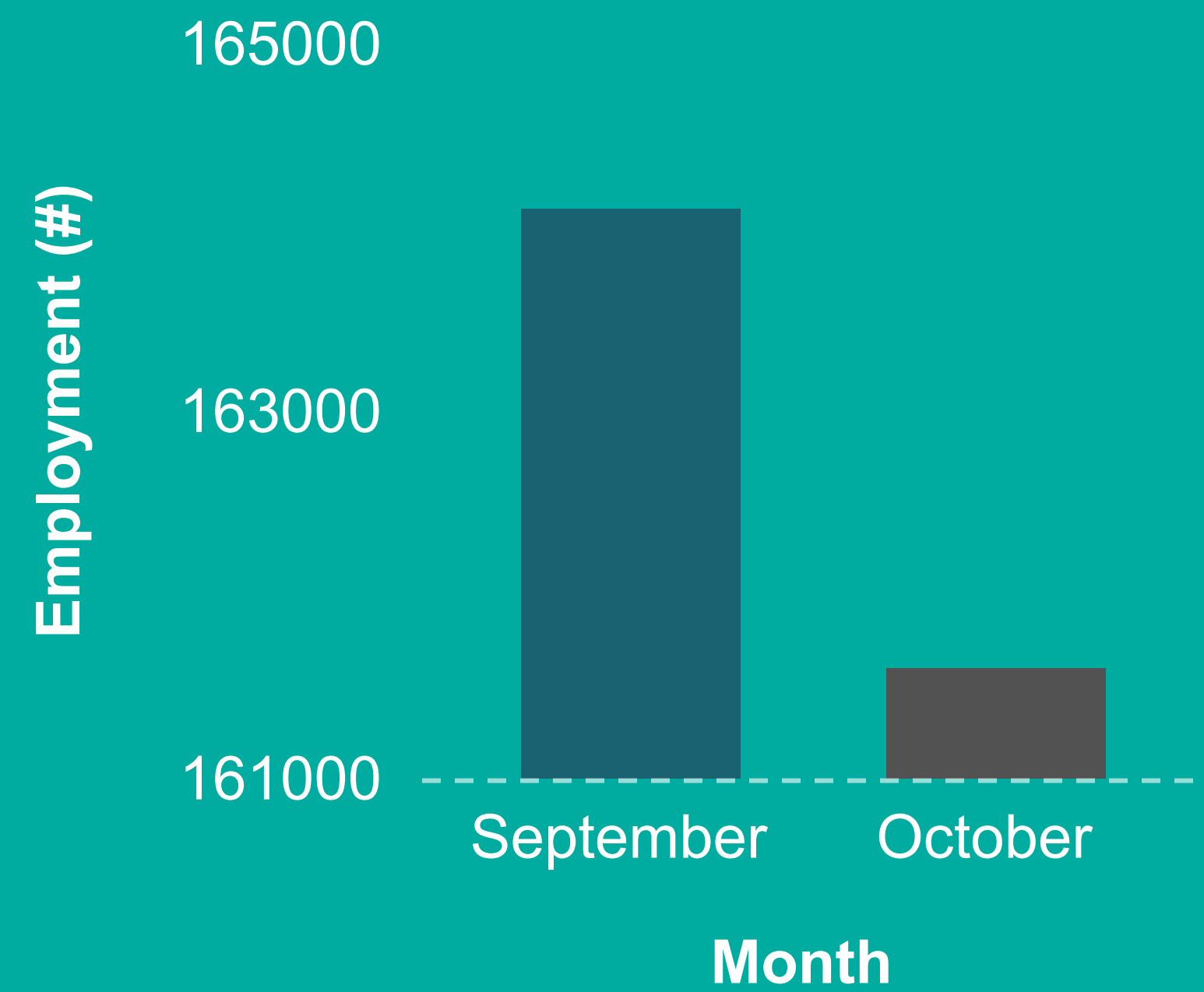

Labour Force



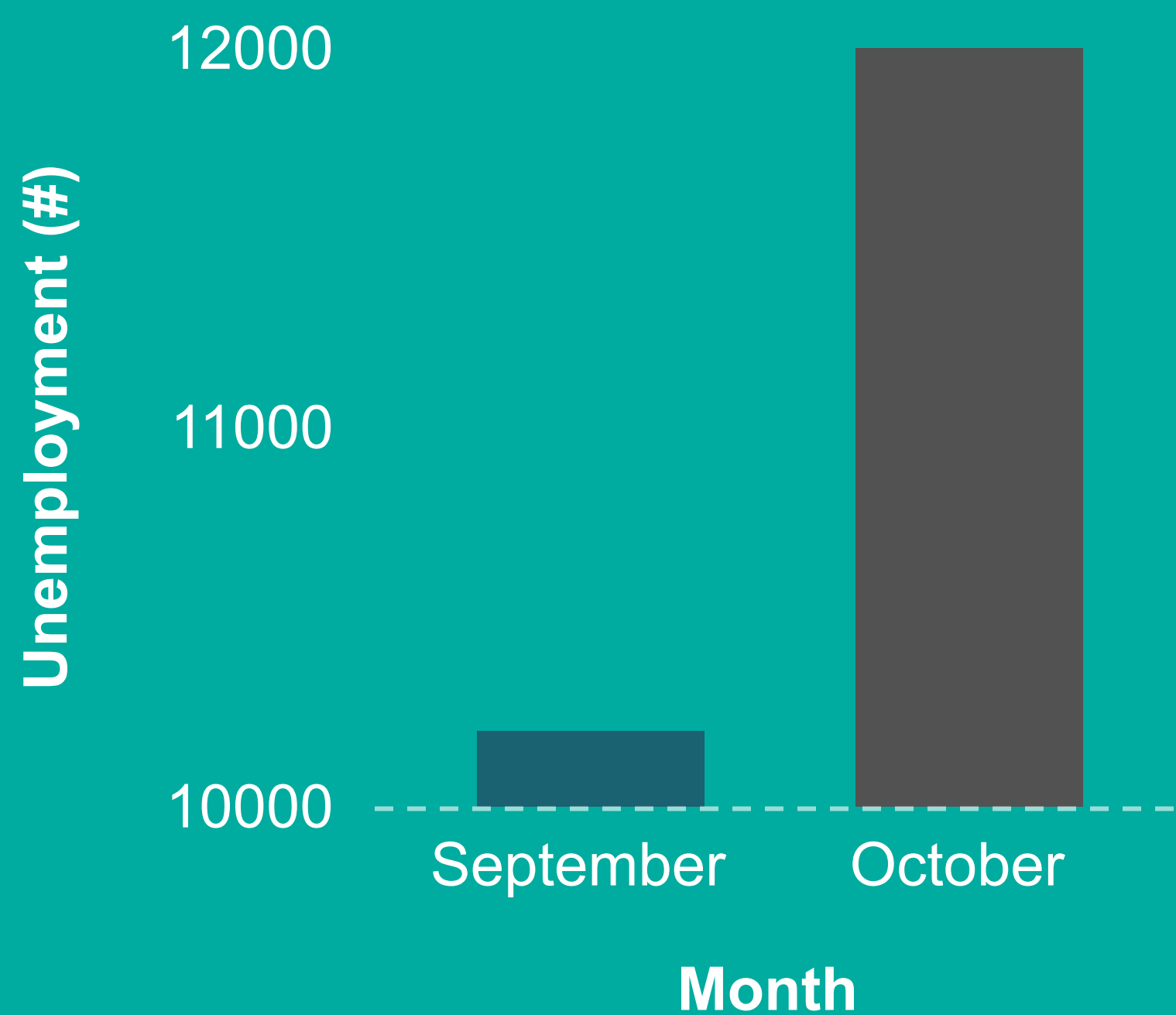
The labour force in Windsor CMA decreased 700 from 174,400 in September to 173,700 in October.

Employment



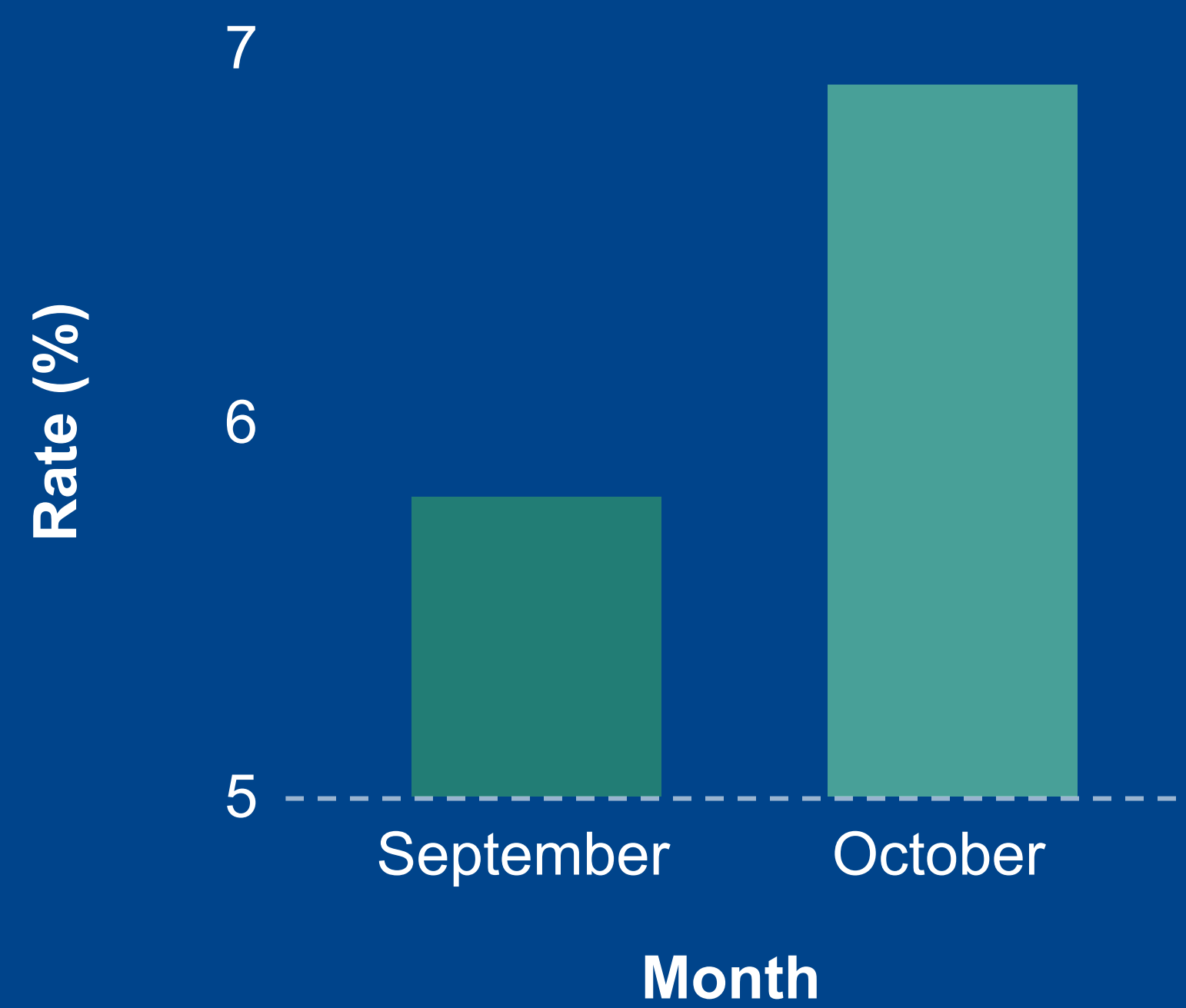
The level of employment in the Windsor CMA decreased 2,500 from 164,100 in September to 161,600 in October.

Unemployment



The number of unemployed individuals increased 1,800 from 10,200 in September to 12,000 in October.

Unemployment Rate



The unemployment rate increased 1.1% from 5.8% in September to 6.9% in October.

Windsor CMA Participation Rate: 60.7%

Unemployment rate of Ontario: 5.9%

The unemployment rate of Windsor CMA is 1.6% higher than 12 months ago.

The labour force is seasonally adjusted, accounting and averaging for peaks in hiring around holidays, summer, etc.

The figures fall within the standard of error.
