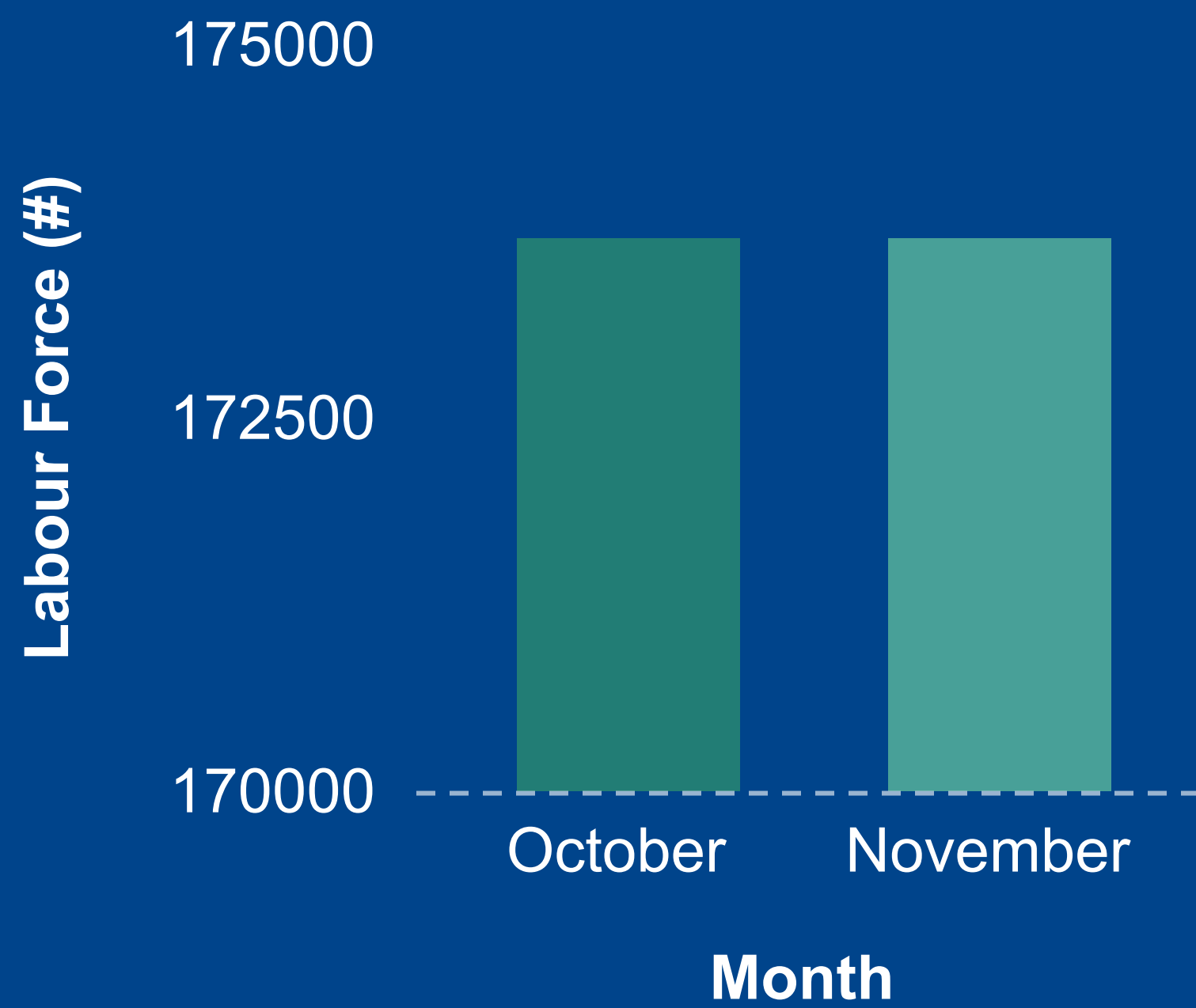

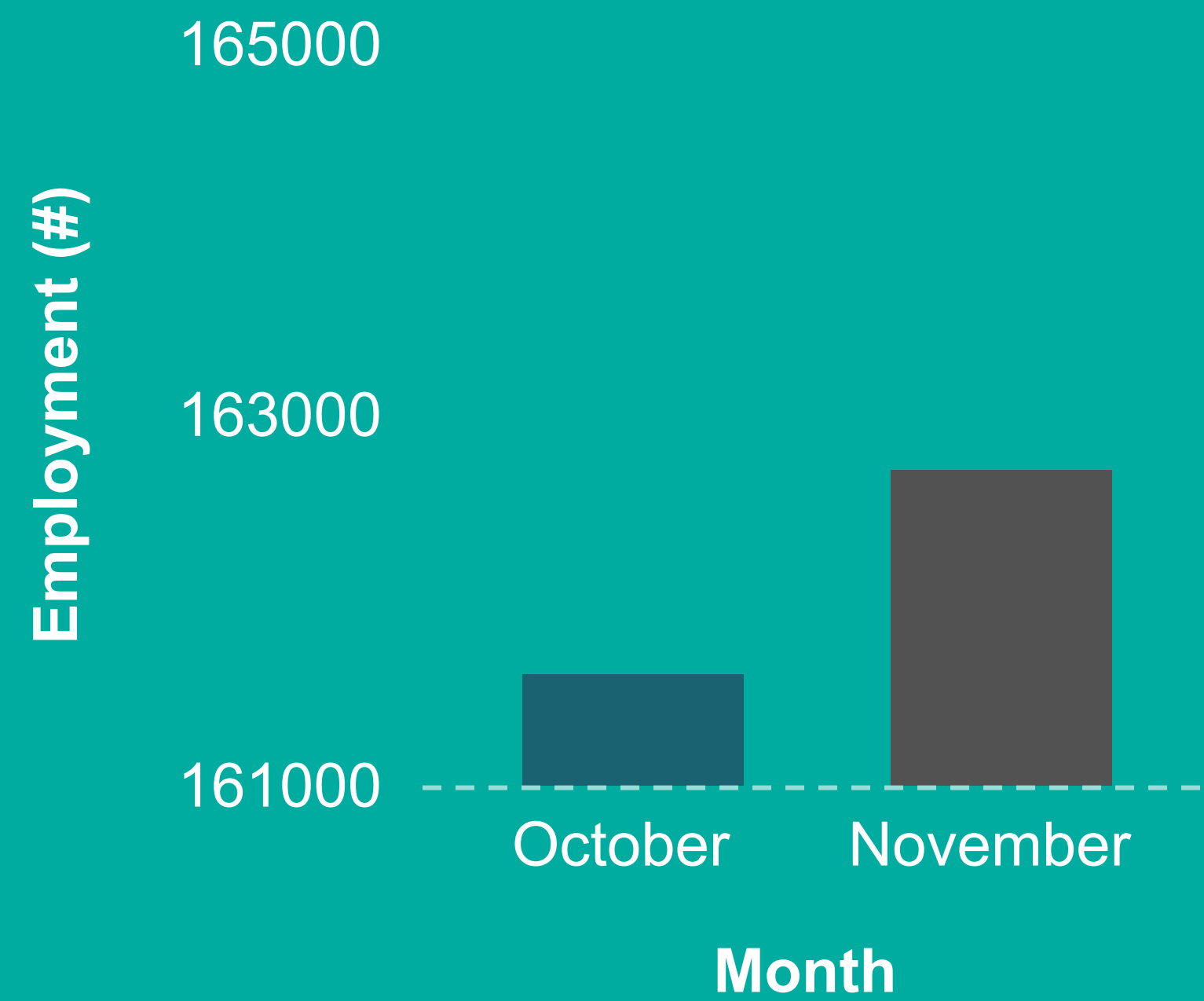

Labour Force



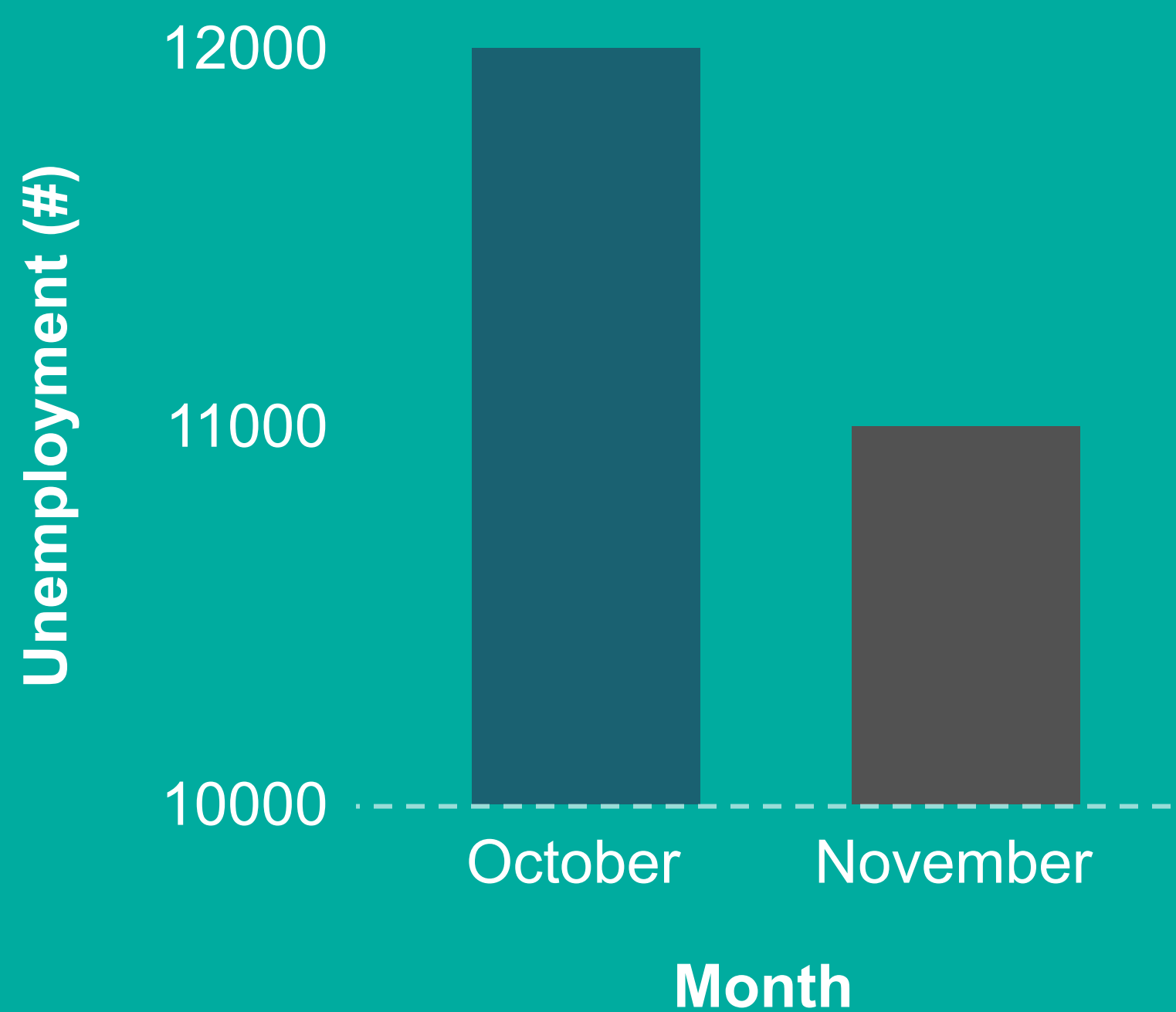
The labour force in Windsor CMA remained the same from October to November at 173,700.

Employment



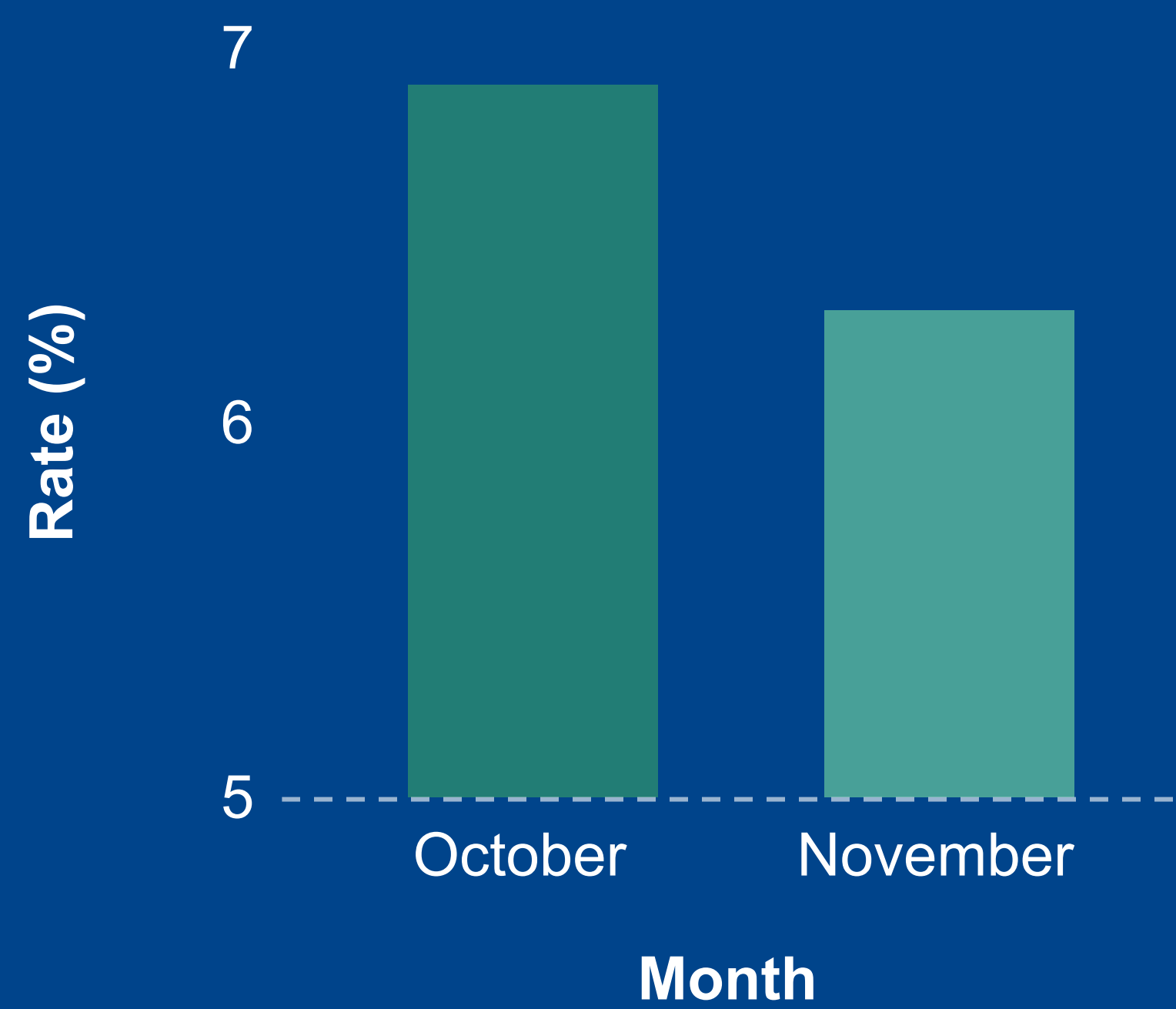
The level of employment in Windsor CMA increased 1,100 from 161,600 in October to 162,700 in November.

Unemployment



The number of unemployed individuals decreased 1,000 from 12,000 in October to 11,000 in November.

Unemployment Rate



The unemployment rate decreased 0.6% from 6.9% in October to 6.3% in November.

Windsor CMA Participation Rate: 60.6%

Unemployment rate of Ontario: 5.5%

The unemployment rate of Windsor CMA is 0.5% higher than 12 months ago.

The labour force is seasonally adjusted, accounting and averaging for peaks in hiring around holidays, summer, etc.

The figures fall within the standard of error.
