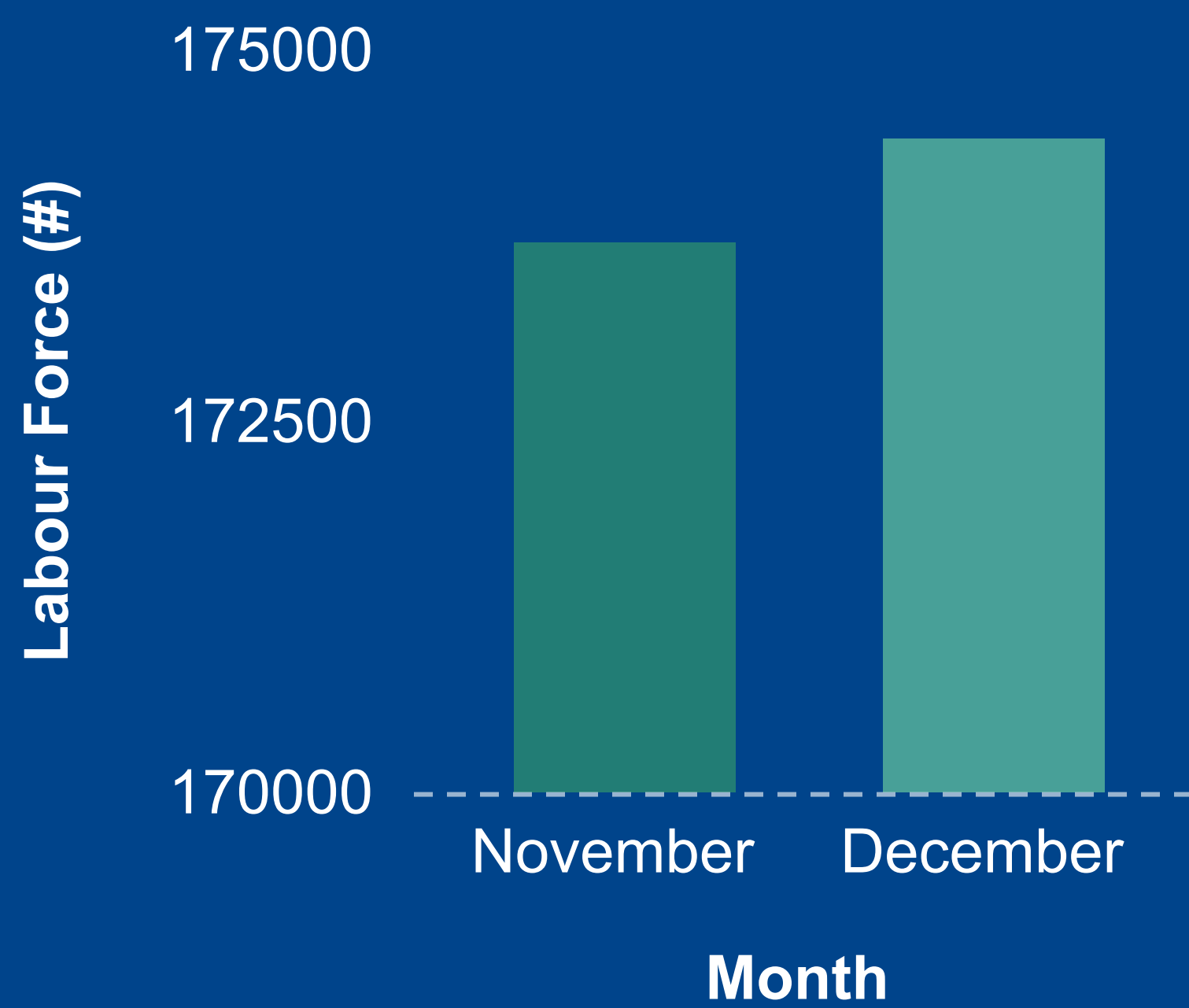

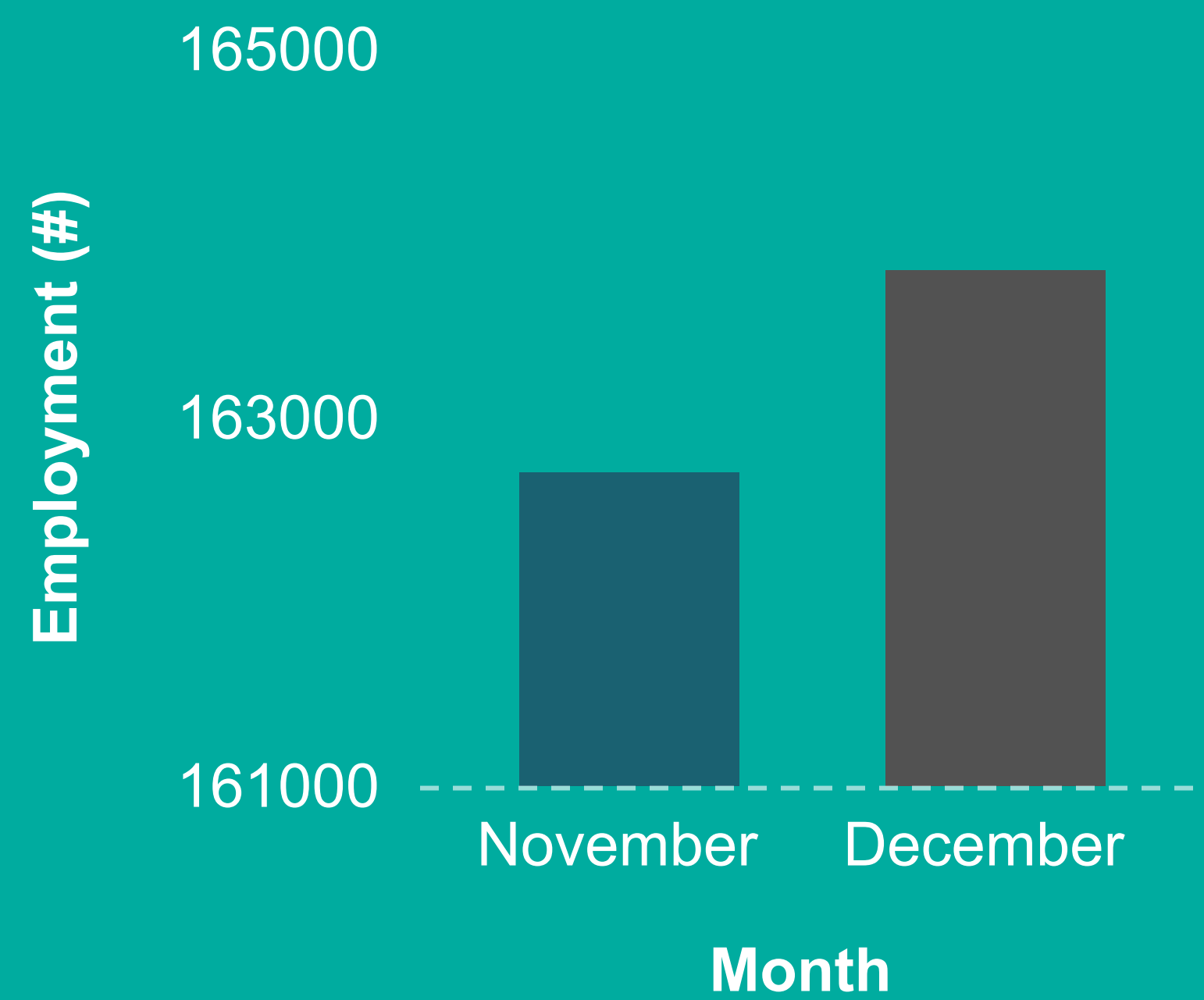

## Labour Force



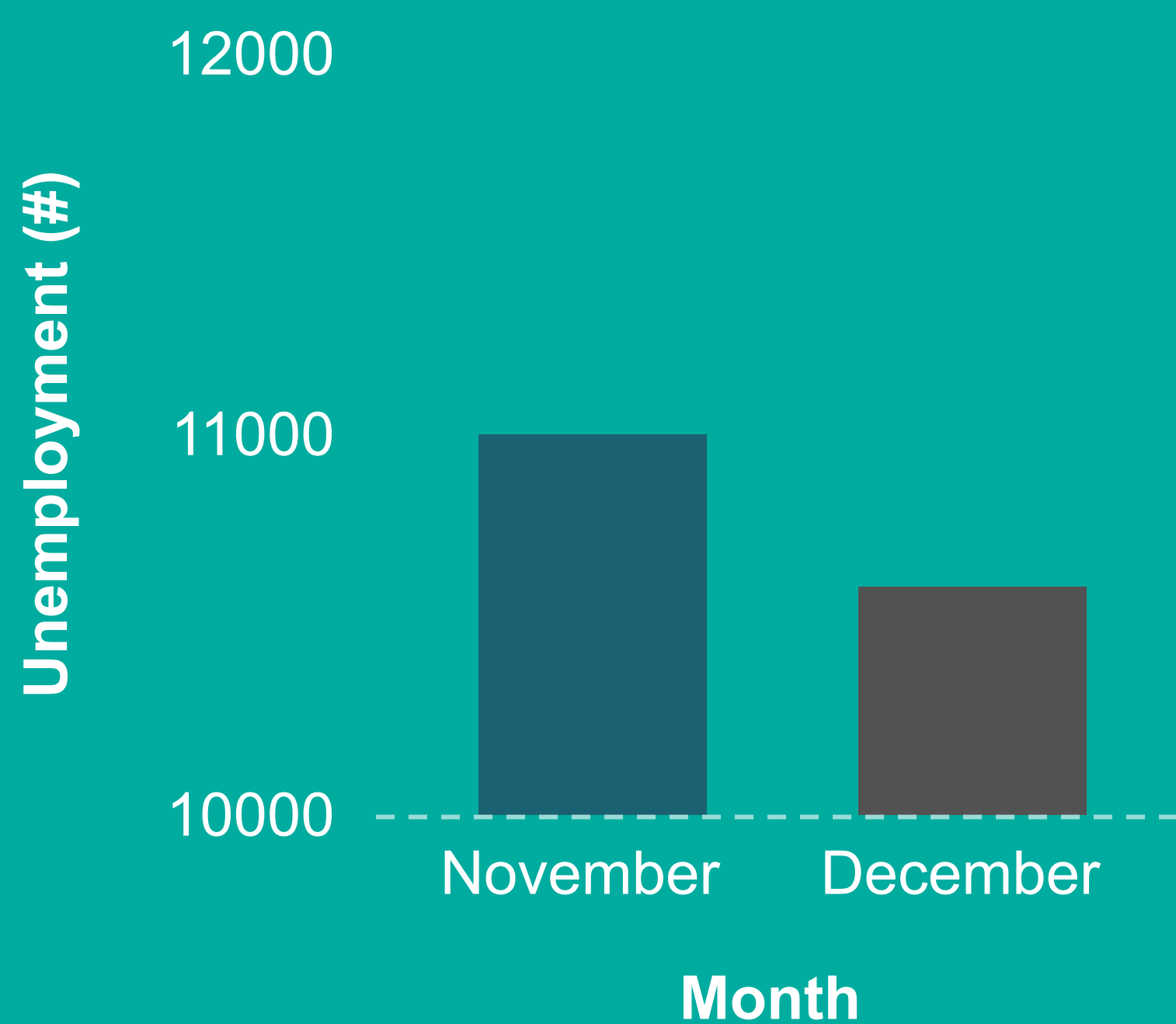
The labour force in Windsor CMA increased 700 from 173,700 in November to 174,400 in December.

## Employment



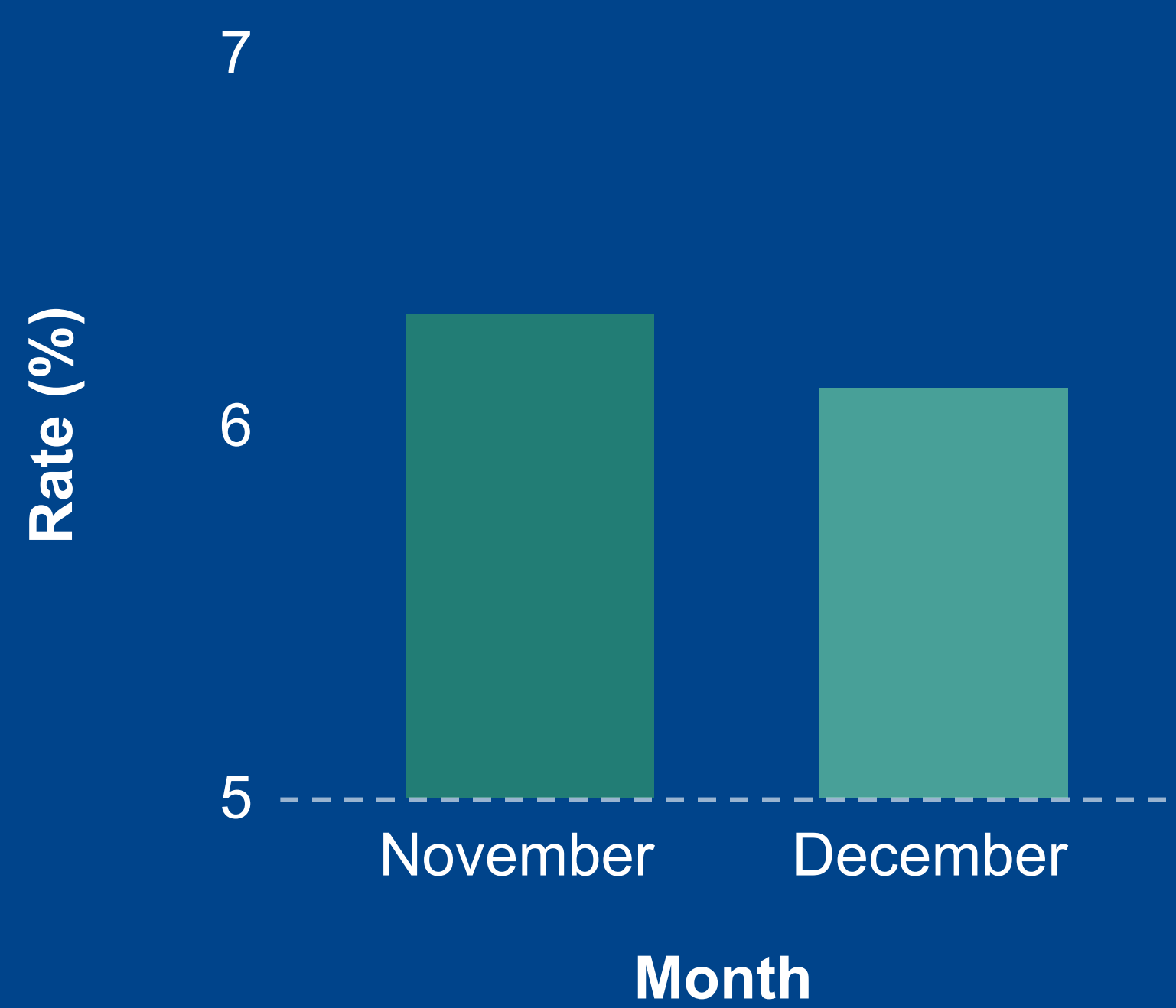
The level of employment in Windsor CMA increased 1,100 from 162,700 in November to 163,800 in December.

## Unemployment



The number of unemployed individuals decreased 400 from 11,000 in November to 10,600 in December.

## Unemployment Rate



The unemployment rate decreased 0.2% from 6.3% in November to 6.1% in December.

Windsor CMA Participation Rate: 60.8%

Unemployment rate of Ontario: 5.5%

The unemployment rate of Windsor CMA is 0.4% higher than 12 months ago.

The labour force is seasonally adjusted, accounting and averaging for peaks in hiring around holidays, summer, etc.

The figures fall within the standard of error.
