




EMPLOYMENT RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS

How has the employment rate changed over the last 13 months?




EMPLOYMENT RATE: YEAR OVER YEAR BY MONTH

How does the employment rate compare over the past 15 years?








UNEMPLOYMENT RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS

How has the unemployment rate changed over the last 13 months?




UNEMPLOYMENT RATE: YEAR OVER YEAR BY MONTH




PARTICIPATION RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS

PARTICIPATION RATE: YEAR OVER YEAR BY MONTH


How does the participation rate compare against last year's participation rate?

How does the participation rate compare over the past 15 years?




