




EMPLOYMENT RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS

EMPLOYMENT RATE: PAST 15 YEARS BY MONTH










UNEMPLOYMENT RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS

How does the unemployment rate compare over the past 15 years?








PARTICIPATION RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS

How has the participation rate changed over the last 13 months?




PARTICIPATION RATE: YEAR OVER YEAR BY MONTH


