


Cannabis Information Session January 4, 2019

The Windsor-Essex and Chatham-Kent Orientation Advisory Committee (OAC) and WE LIP SPICE Committee collaborated to organize a Professional Learning Circle. The half day Cannabis Information Session was held on January 4, 2019 and was delivered to 51 front line settlement and City of Windsor staff with the intent of providing resources and information that can be shared with clients on a one-on-one basis, and/or in a workshop format.
