AGRICULTURAL COMMUNITY WELLNESS CLINIC


On October 24th, 2021, WE LIP supported the Agricultural Workers Wellness Clinic held in Leamington. The event was in cooperation with the Black Physicians' Association of Ontario (BPAO) to improve outreach and answer questions of Black, African, and Caribbean agricultural workers regarding the COVID-19 vaccine.

Volunteers from ten (10) different agencies and networks, and three (3) doctors from the Black Physicians Association of Ontario (BPAO) were on site to provide information and answer question. Over the course of the event 144 vaccines were administered. As well, the Windsor Essex Community Health Centre's Mobile Unit was on site to offer primary care support. Giveaways included backpacks, sanitizing wipes, respirator masks, Medi-Stick pain reliever, neck gaiter scarves, Tim Horton's gift cards and snacks.
