### WELCOME TO THE CONSUL OF MEXICO – VANESSA CALVA RUIZ

On November 17<sup>th</sup>, the WE LIP Coordination Team had the pleasure of meeting with the new Consul of Mexico in Leamington, Vanessa Calva Ruiz.

This meeting came together at the suggestion of Leamington Mayor, Hilda MacDonald, who recognized the value and opportunities that partnering with WE LIP can provide.

A career diplomat, Consul Calva arrived in July 2021 as the new Consul of Mexico responsible for Windsor-Essex, Chatham-Kent and Lambton county.



While many of her duties revolve around the Mexican nationals who take part in the Seasonal Worker Agricultural Program in Ontario, it is essential to Consul Calva to engage with the extended Mexican population that live and work in Essex County, and to be an active partner in the work of local stakeholders.

Since her arrival, Consul Calva has visited farms and greenhouses to speak with Mexican workers about the different services the Consulate provides, like issuing passports and powers of attorney, as well as information sessions available on topics like financial literacy, and pension and health benefits.

To provide better assistance to the community, the Consulate is open one Saturday a month to process Mexican passports and to consult with the community to address any need they have while in Canada. **The next Saturday session - or *Jornada Sabatina* - will be on December 4<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.**

Consul Calva has also met and exchanged ideas with stakeholders, and service and community organizations to identify potential collaborative initiatives beyond the traditional consular services:

As part of these extended engagements, the Windsor Essex Community Health Centre (weCHC) has offered free glucose exams in the Consulate on their working Saturdays, and provided preventive information about diabetes, nutrition and general health. **On Saturday December 4<sup>th</sup> the Consulate will host a COVID-19 vaccination site open to the public in need of a first, second or third doses. This clinic is open to all public regardless of their immigration status or access to OHIP. Vaccines will be available from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.**
