




EMPLOYMENT RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS







EMPLOYMENT RATE: YEAR OVER YEAR BY MONTH




UNEMPLOYMENT RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS




PARTICIPATION RATE: PAST 13 MONTHS






PARTICIPATION RATE: YEAR OVER YEAR BY MONTH


